3. It doesn't matter which way you draw the picture! (Horizontally or Vertically) Can you please draw a picture of men (the US government) giving blankets and food? Can you also please draw a picture of happy Native Americans and happy men (the US Government)?
4. Please draw three pictures. One of a cat being a barista, one of a dog, and one of a mouse. (Dog and Mouse are friends with each other and customers of the cat). Please put all of the scenes at a coffee shop. Keep in mind that the mouse and cat do not like each other.
5. Please draw a picture of Alexander Hamilton and label it Alexander Hamilton.
6. Please draw a pink piggy bank with bank labeled on the side.

7. Please draw some dollar bills and some coins.

8. Please draw a picture of several monkeys that look cartoonish, that are wearing British hats, and jumping on land.

9. Turn your piece of paper horizontally. Draw two different drawings of someone who has an idea! Make it colorful and creative. Thank you!

10. Turn your paper horizontally. Please draw a bunch of money all over the page this includes green paper money and coins. Thanks so much!
