

iPad Restrictions

1. To turn on Restrictions > Go into Settings > Select General > Select Restrictions



2. Select "Enable Restrictions" at the top of the screen
3. Enter a 4 digit passcode that only you (the parent) will know and then confirm again.



4. Now you are able to “control” what options you wish to turn off or on the device. The image below represents options that will not interfere with a students ability to do school work and still have the most restrictions on the device.



Safari is “on” so that students are still able to gather information from teacher websites, resource databases, etc..

The camera is “on” because it is used in many classes to complete assignments.

FaceTime is “off”

iTunes is “off”, this will not interfere with any iTunes U course that is needed at school.

iBookstore is “on” so that downloading books is an option

Installing and Deleting apps is “off”, teachers will give students a 24 hour time period to download apps at home if needed at school the next day. In order to download an app you will need to turn “on” installing apps, download the app from the app store or HUB and then turn installing apps back “off”

Music & Podcasts has explicit turned “off”

Movies & TV Shows has “don’t allow” selected

Books has explicit sexual content turned “off”

Make sure to leave Apps to “all” so that apps currently used do not disappear.

In-App Purchases is “off”

Require Password is changed to “immediately”
