ISM-01 Pass-Around Microphone

Using

- Turn microphone on by sliding the Power Switch up. See Image 32
- 2. Note Power Indicator (chair icon).

Green = On and transmitting **Off** = Power is off

NOTE: In order to conserve battery life, if power switch is left on, your microphone will automatically go into Standby Mode (off) after 10 minutes of silence. Move switch to off position, then back on to reset.

- Keep top of microphone approximately
 4-4in. (7.5 10cm) from mouth when using as a hand-held microphone. See Image 33
- 4. Do not block emitter diodes. See Image 32
- To allow hands-free use (for example, when reading aloud and turning pages), attach the lavaliere clip and neck strap.
 Adjust neck strap to position microphone approximately 4 - 5in (10 - 13cm) from mouth. See Image 34
- 6. When needed, you can simply push and hold the Power Switch while talking rather than sliding it into the "on" position. This makes transitions when passing the microphone between students easier (e.g., no need to take time from the conversation to turn the mic on and off during transition). For best results, when using the push-to-talk function, be sure to press on the lower section of the switch. See Image 32
- When the battery in your microphone gets low (approximately 1/2 hour of use time left) the battery indicator will flash red.
 See Image 32
- 8. Turn off microphone and charge at the end of the day. (See page 34)

NOTE: The ISM-01 is factory set on Channel B. Each microphone must be on a separate channel. See *Programming and Switching the Microphone Channels* on page 36.




