











Personalize Your iPad Wallpaper and Lock Screen



Objective: Using the Draw Free App students will personalize their iPad wallpaper and lock screen

❶ Design your Wallpaper:

- Set your iPad up to work in PORTRAIT  mode, make sure the HOME button is at the bottom
- Open the DRAW FREE  app on your iPad
- Tap the + sign
- Tap 
- Tap 
- Press  to use the FRONT facing camera
- Make sure your face and shoulders are in the shot and make a nice smiling face
- Press the  button at the bottom
- Press  if the picture is good. Press  if you need to try again
- Tap outside the camera window
- Tap  (the 2nd tool) and choose a color
- Tap outside of the pencil box to start drawing
- Change the thickness of the pencil using the slider  at the top
- Write your iPad number on the top LEFT
- Write your name under your chin

❷ Send your picture to the Camera Roll

- Tap 
- Tap 
- Tap **OK** to allow Draw Free to Access Your Photos*
- Close Draw Free

❸ Setting your Wallpaper and Lock Screen:

- Open the Photos  app
- Find your photo with your name and number on it
- Tap 
- Tap 
- Tap 
- Close the app
